- Someone who loves all people and is comfortable interacting with both church and unchurched, and is passionate about reaching the local community through prayerful understanding, involvement, and service.
- Skilled in sharing the gospel with truth and grace and equipping others to do so also.
- A great team player that is faithful, takes initiative, is humble and dependable.
- Joyful doctrinal agreement with NCBC's Leadership Affirmation of Faith.
- Maintains confidentiality and professionalism at all times.
- Ability to handle conflict constructively and graciously.
- Skilled in a working knowledge of event planning, program management, and communication.
- Efficient in transforming big ideas into realistic ministries of the local church.
- Discerning awareness of Mission and Outreach trends, issues, and resources.
- Demonstrated cross-cultural/rural ministry competencies.
- Growing prayer life.
- Effective communication skills (written, verbal, and interpersonal).
- Residency in Goodfield recommended, but not required.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and lead evangelism efforts to the least reached in the local communities, especially within a 15-mile radius of Goodfield, IL.
- Lead and develop our Goodfield Ministry Team (GMT). Recruit, train, schedule, organize, and coach the GMT to "glorify God by growing deeper and reaching farther."
- Be a leader of leaders by developing people, building teams and multiplying leaders.
- Oversee and champion all of NCBC's ministry in Goodfield IL.
- Oversee and implement NCBC's evangelism strategy; teaching and equipping disciples in personal and corporate evangelism.
- Develop and manage strategic community partnerships with local organizations, businesses, schools, etc. in Goodfield and the surrounding communities.
- Plan and execute outreach events and initiatives to reach Goodfield and the surrounding communities.
- Cooperate with other local evangelical churches for evangelism and outreach.
- Assist elders with local church planting initiatives.
- Work closely with our Communications Director to leverage our website, livestreams, social media, etc. for outreach purposes.
- Continue to learn and grow in utilizing technology to reach our local communities for Jesus.
- Attend and provide input at regular meetings for NCBC Staff and Outreach Leadership Team.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
